
My name is Toula Campbell and I am assisting in this written request on behalf of my father whose English is limited.

We are writing to request a further extension of time to respond to the Complaint in this matter. You previously provided my father with extensions until June 1, 2017, which allowed us to conserve and apply my father's limited resources towards settlement negotiations. We have engaged in settlement discussions with the receivership's attorney, Christopher Cavallo, and have submitted a settlement proposal. We are patiently awaiting a reply and hope to fully resolve this matter without having to retain counsel. We respectfully request an additional thirty day extension to continue these settlement negotiations. We apologize for making this request beyond the June 1, 2017 deadline; however, it took longer than expected to obtain proof of my father's financial means to include in the settlement proposal.

In accordance with Local Rule 7.1.A.3, we have spoken with attorney Cavallo who has indicated that the Plaintiff does not oppose this extension on the basis that we are engaged in settlement negotiations.
