**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH
RULE 4(M) OF THE FEDERAL RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE**

THIS CAUSE is before the Court *sua sponte*.


Pursuant to Rule 4(m) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure (the “Rules”), service of the summons and complaint is to be perfected upon defendants within 90 days after the filing of the complaint. A review of the Court record reveals that this action was filed on November 2, 2016. *See* [DE 1]. Therefore, the deadline to serve process on Defendants under Rule 4(m) has passed. There is no indication that the Defendants Jose Roffe, Mireille Roffe, Laas Turnbull, or Omri Tintpulver have been served.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. On or before **June 7, 2017**, Plaintiff shall either perfect service upon Defendants Jose Roffe, Mireille Roffe, Laas Turnbull, and Omri Tintpulver, show that service has already been made, or show good cause as to why service has not been

perfected; and Failure to timely respond will result in immediate dismissal of this case without prejudice as to those Defendants.
