ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Court *sua sponte*. On July 22, 2017, Plaintiff, Grisel Alonso, served copies of the summons and complaint on Defendants, Victor Elmaleh; Mercedes Elmaleh; 1925333 Ontario Inc.; Engage Marketing Group, Inc.; and M3 Designs, LP. (*See* Summons Returned Executed [ECF Nos. 9–13]). On October 17, 2017, the Court issued an Order [ECF No. 36] requiring the corporate Defendants to retain counsel and all Defendants to file a combined response or separate answers to the Complaint [ECF No. 1] on or before October 24, 2017. (*See* Order 2). While Victor Elmaleh and Mercedes Elmaleh have filed Answers (*see* [ECF Nos. 34, 37]) to the Complaint, the remaining Defendants have failed to answer or respond.


Accordingly, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Plaintiff shall submit a *motion for entry of clerk's default* against 1925333 Ontario Inc.; Engage Marketing Group, Inc.; and M3 Designs, LP by **November 1, 2017**, that includes the certificates of service indicating notices were sent to Defendants, including the address or addresses to which notices were sent. Plaintiff's failure to file the *motion for entry of clerk's default* within the specified time may result in **dismissal**

without prejudice and without further notice as to these Defendants. It is further **ORDERED** that Plaintiff and Defendants Victor Elmaleh and Mercedes Elmaleh shall file their certificates of interested parties and a joint scheduling report by **November 1, 2017**.
