**ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S RECOMMENDATION
FOR OBJECTION PROCEDURE RELATED TO SECOND DISTRIBUTION**

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on the Receiver's Motion for Court Approval of Second Distribution to Holders of Approved Claims ("Motion"), filed on June 2, 2022. [DE 244]. The Court notes that the Securities and Exchange Commission does not object to the relief sought by Receiver in the Motion.

Having considered the Motion, and being otherwise fully advised, it is **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** as follows:


1. The objection schedule proposed by the Receiver in the Motion is **GRANTED**;
2. The Court approves the Receiver's recommended objection and hearing schedule

as follows:

- A. Within 5 days of the entry of this Order, the Receiver shall serve this Order on all holders of Allowed and Modified Claims by emailing it to them, when possible (using the most recent contact information available to the Receiver).
- B. Holders of Allowed and Modified Claims shall have thirty (30) days from the service date of this Order to object in writing to the Receiver's recommendations. Holders of Allowed and Modified Claims shall: (i) file their objections with the Court; and (ii) send their objections to the Receiver via email at Grisel@Alonso-Receiver.com, or by mail to the Receiver's office, Grisel Alonso, Receiver, Grisel Alonso and Associates, LLC, 2525 Ponce de Leon Blvd., Suite 300, Coral Gables, FL 33134, **to be received** no later than thirty (30) days from the service date of this Order;
- C. If objections are sent to the Receiver by regular mail, holders of Allowed and Modified Claims must request proof of delivery and/or return receipt;
- D. If a holder of an Allowed and Modified Claim does not object within the time frame provided, the Receiver's recommendations will be deemed sustained with prejudice as to that holder, and the right of that holder to object will be deemed irrevocably waived;
- E. Within twenty (20) days of the deadline for holder objections, the Receiver shall file her responses to timely-filed objections;
- F. To the extent necessary, the Court may set a hearing for a date after the Receiver's responses to objections are due to rule on any objections that are timely filed; and

G. The Receiver shall serve a copy of this Order on each holder an Allowed and Modified Claim by electronic mail when possible, using the most recent contact information available to her, and shall post a copy of this order on the Receivership website: www.elmtreereceivership.com.
