ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S SECOND DISTRIBUTION

3. The Receiver shall distribute funds to holders of Allowed and Modified Claims in accordance with the Motion and the Rising Tide Proposed Proposed Final Distribution, using funds held in the Receivership Estate.

4. The Receiver shall serve a copy of this Order on each holder an Allowed and Modified Claim by electronic mail when possible, using the most recent contact information available to her, and shall post a copy of this order on the Receivership website: www.elmtreereceivership.com.
