**ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S FINAL REPORT,
REQUEST FOR PAYMENT OF FEES AND COSTS,
AND MOTION TO CLOSE RECEIVERSHIP**


THIS CAUSE is before the Court on the Receiver's Final Report, Request for Payment of Fees and Costs, and Motion to Close Receivership ("Motion"), filed on March 9, 2023. [DE 252]. The Court notes that the Securities and Exchange Commission does not object to the relief sought by Receiver in the Motion.

Having considered the Motion, as well as the Receiver's notice that no objections were received to the Motion [DE 252], and being otherwise fully advised, it is **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Court hereby **APPROVES AND GRANTS** the Receiver's Final Report, Request for Payment of Fees and Costs, and Motion to Close Receivership [DE 252].

2. The Receiver is granted authority to pay the remaining professional fees and expenses of \$16,191.75 to Alonso and Associates and \$5,200 to Nelson Mullins;
3. Grisel Alonso is discharged as Receiver;
4. Grisel Alonso is discharged from any and all continuing duties;
5. Any claimant, Defendant, any creditors, and/or any individual or entity with any interest whatsoever to the monies or assets recovered and distributed under the Claims Process, or otherwise, is barred from bringing any claim or cause of action against Grisel Alonso, her counsel, consultants, accountants, employees, designees, and/or her agents arising, in any way, from Ms. Alonso's duties as Receiver;
6. The Receiver is authorized to file for dissolution of the Receivership Entities;
7. The Receiver is authorized to destroy any obsolete records in her possession immediately, and all Receivership records after 6 years without further notice or hearing;
8. The Receiver is authorized to close all accounts, including accounts maintained at banks, brokerages, and other financial institutions.
9. This case shall remain **CLOSED**.
